Our Center will be an oasis. Welcoming and filled with light, the 64,000 square foot Center is designed to lift the spirits and expand the possibilities of our families, our volunteers, our frontline staff, and the community of South Norfolk. Serene counseling rooms overlook children's play areas; a rooftop garden will be a green sanctuary for families to gather, play, and grow vegetables. Our education center will include "makerspaces" where our children can learn, create, and innovate using state-of-the-art-tools.

Our Center will be a regional resource. When it opens this spring, the Landmark Center will connect more than 85,000 individuals to services. And what a time to open the doors! As the pandemic continues, it especially ravages impoverished communities. Our work to end the cycle of poverty and homelessness has never been more urgent. The Center will more than triple the number of beds currently available at our emergency shelter. More importantly, the facility will serve as a trama-informed, efficient, and inviting space where children and families from all across Hampton Roads can take their first steps on their path out of poverty.

There is still more work to do. We must raise \$900,000 to complete our \$25 million capital campaign, and there are seemingly endless details to tackle to make our Center a welcoming respite for our most vulnerable neighbors. But, thanks to all of you, we are almost home.

135-bed Family Shelter will more than **triple**ForKids current bed capacity
